NEW EXAMINATION ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE RADIO OPERATOR'S SHORT RANGE CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY (SRC)

On 24th November 2003, a new examination structure for the SRC examination was implemented. A Panel of External Examiners has been appointed by the Maritime Safety Directorate to conduct the examinations, and these examinations will continue for the time being to be examined in modular form. Currently there are thirteen External Examiners on the panel, and this number will be increased further within the coming weeks.

It is proposed to publish the names and contact details for each External Examiner, and an Examination Schedule, in addition to the names and details of Course Providers, on the Department's website www.dcmnr.gov.ie as soon as possible. Examination Application Forms and Ship Station (Radio) Licence Forms are also available on the website.

The new panel augments the existing complement of Radio Examiners and is directly responsible to the Principal Radio Surveyor/Examiner.
