

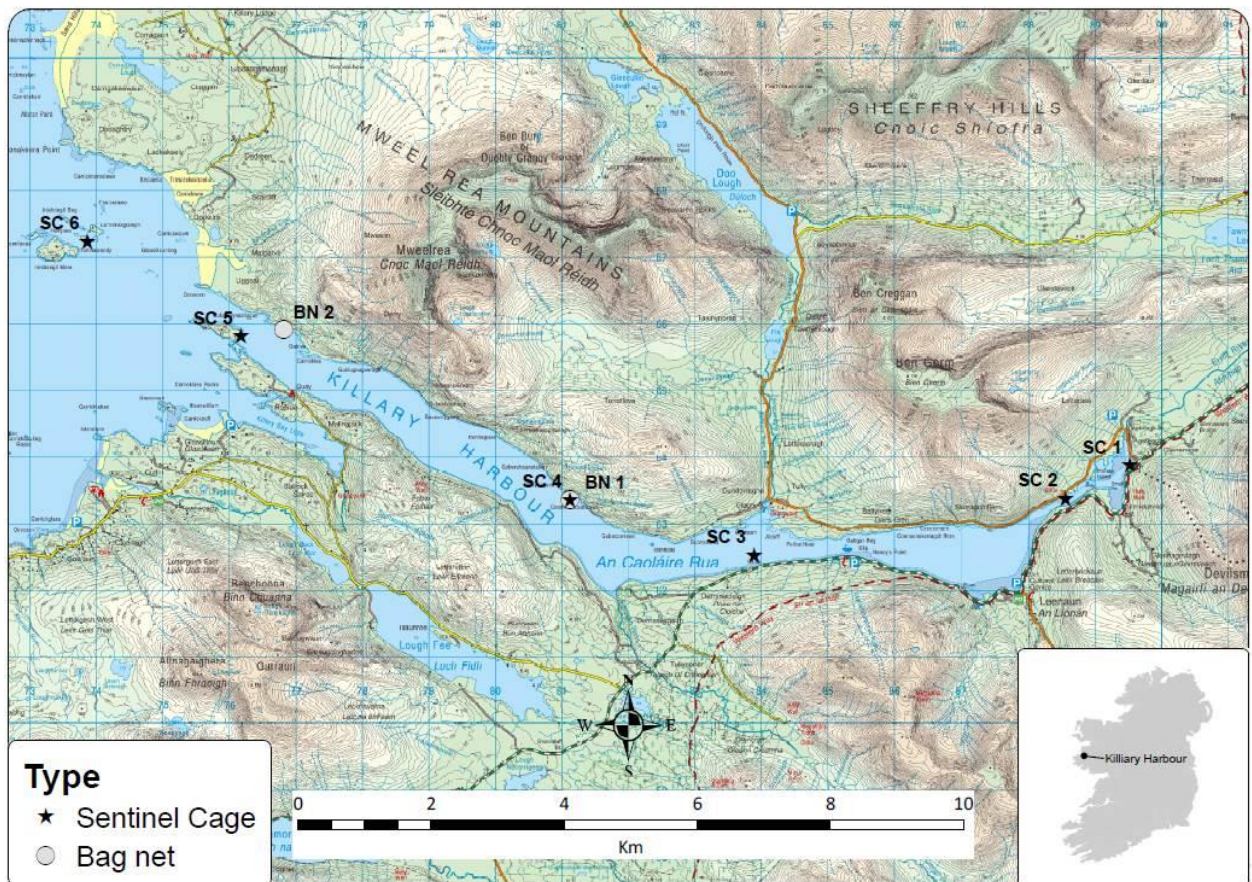
## Marine Notice No. 16 of 2017

Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishers,  
Yachtsmen and Seafarers

### Deployment of Bag-Nets and Sentinel Cages in Killary Harbour and Surrounding Waters

The Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport has been advised that Inland Fisheries Ireland (IFI) will be carrying out scientific sampling using bag-nets and sentinel cages in Killary Harbour and surrounding waters. The bag-nets will start at the shore and extend into the water approximately 25 metres. The sentinel cages (nets) will be anchored near-shore and will not interfere with navigable waters. All nets will be clearly marked with brightly coloured buoys with IFI identification so that any unintentional retrieval can be notified to IFI through the contact details provided.

Deployment operations will be carried out using an IFI RIB “*Sea Breeze*” (call sign **EI-5724**, MMSI 250002937) and will take place on the **3rd April 2017**, subject to weather conditions. The nets will be checked daily (weather dependent) and all sampling nets and buoys will be retrieved on the **2<sup>nd</sup> June 2017**.
