

Marine Notice No. 27 of 2017

Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishers and Seafarers

Deployment of Sampling Nets in Bertraghboy Bay, Connemara

The Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport has been advised that the Marine Institute will be carrying out scientific sampling using passive sampling bag nets in Bertraghboy bay and surrounding waters. The nets will extend perpendicularly outwards from the shoreline shore for approximately 30 metres. The nets will be clearly marked with brightly coloured buoys (mainly orange) and labelled with the Marine Institute identification. The nets will be checked daily (weather permitting). Deployment will be between **June 26th 2017 and August 21st 2017** (weather permitting). Nets will be deployed using a small, open boat, powered by an out-board engine.

The sampling bag nets will be deployed at and around this location:
