

## Marine Notice No. 17 of 2015

Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishermen, Yachtsmen and Seafarers

### Corrib Gas Field Maintenance and Pre-commissioning

The Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport has been advised that maintenance and pre-commissioning activities will be carried out on the Corrib field. The work will all take place within the 500m Safety Zone surrounding the Corrib subsea facilities, and more specifically at:

Corrib P5 (18/25-3) well	54° 19' 11.136" N	11° 04' 15.419" W
Corrib P6 (18/20-5) well	54° 20' 18.224" N	11° 03' 26.705" W

Works will commence around 1<sup>st</sup> June 2015, and are expected to be completed by the end of June 2015, weather permitting and will be carried out by the "Normand Subsea" (Callsign 2CQP8).
