Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishermen,
Yachtsmen and Seafarers

Corrib Water Outfall - Water Quality Survey

The Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport would like to advise that an inshore seawater sampling survey will take place in the vicinity of the Corrib treated surface water outfall diffuser, off the coast of Mayo, located at:

Water Outfall Diffuser 54° 19' 36.722" N 09° 59' 12.342" W

Sub-surface and near-seabed water sampling will be undertaken at several locations around the diffuser, but will be confined to an area delineated by the following locations (WGS 84).

North West	54° 19' 56.265" N	10° 01' 03.151" W
North East	54° 19' 56.427" N	09° 56' 38.090" W
South West	54° 19' 14.867" N	10° 01' 03.151" W
South East	54° 19' 09.577" N	09° 56' 42.727" W

The works will commence around 2nd June 2015 and last for approximately three days weather permitting. All works will be undertaken from the SMS "Leah", (Callsign **MHIU8**).

All mariners are reminded of their responsibilities under the International Collision Regulations and are reminded of [Marine Notice No. 17 of 2007](#), which gives general advice in relation to the activities of vessels engaged in survey work for hydrographic, seismic, fishing research and underwater operations.

The International Regulations for Prevention of Collisions at Sea (COLREGS) are implemented in Irish law by the *Merchant Shipping (Collision Regulations) (Ships and Water Craft on the Water) Order 2012* [S.I. No. 507 of 2012], and the *Signals of Distress (Ships) Rules 2012* [S.I. No.170 of 2012].
