Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishermen, Yachtsmen and Seafarers

Deployment of Two Buoys in the Shannon Estuary

The Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport has been advised that TechWorks Marine. intend on deploying two temporary buoys in the Shannon Estuary. The buoys will be deployed on 29th July 2016 at the following locations:

Name of Buoy	Latitude	Longitude
Buoy 1 – West of Aughinish Pier	52° 38.760'N	009° 03.960' W
Buoy 2 – Just North of Trummera Big	52° 38.450' N,	009° 02.700' W

The buoys are required for the placement of turbidity sensors pre and during a dredge campaign. The buoys will be in position for a period of 4 weeks from Friday 29th July. The data buoys are a 1.2m wide buoy, are yellow in colour and have a Navigation light with the following characteristics:

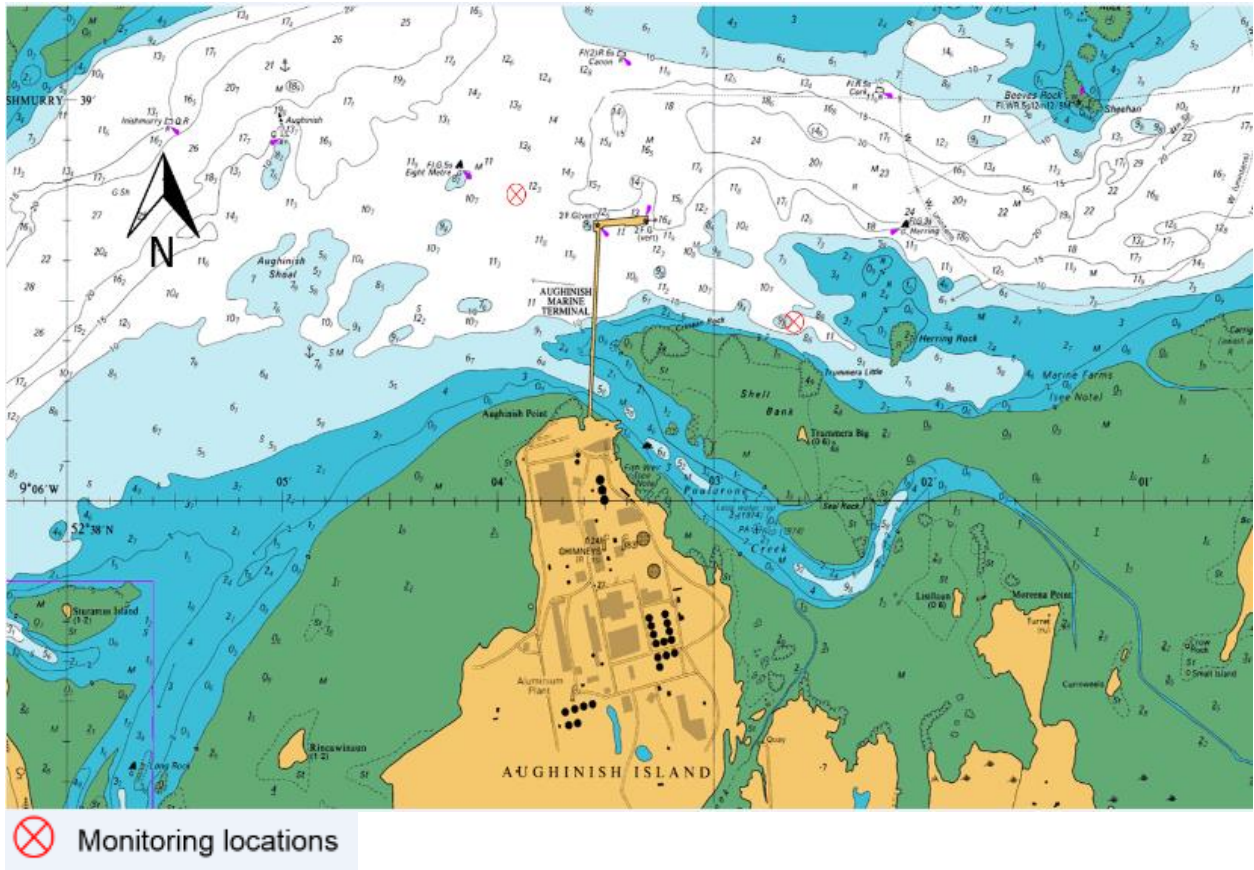
- Yellow, 5 flashes every 20 seconds
- It has a 2 Nautical Mile range

The buoys will be deployed on a single point mooring. A photograph is attached below of what the buoys looks like.
