

## Marine Notice No.46 of 2016

*Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishers, and Seafarers*

**Piling and Pontoon Installation Works at the Trawler Dock, Howth Fishery Harbour Centre, Co. Dublin**

The Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport has been advised that piling works will commence at Howth Fishery Harbour Centre, Co. Dublin, weather permitting, on or around 21<sup>st</sup> November 2016. The works will involve the installation of 3 No. circular steel piles and subsequent installation of a floating pontoon at the Trawler Dock (Western Basin).

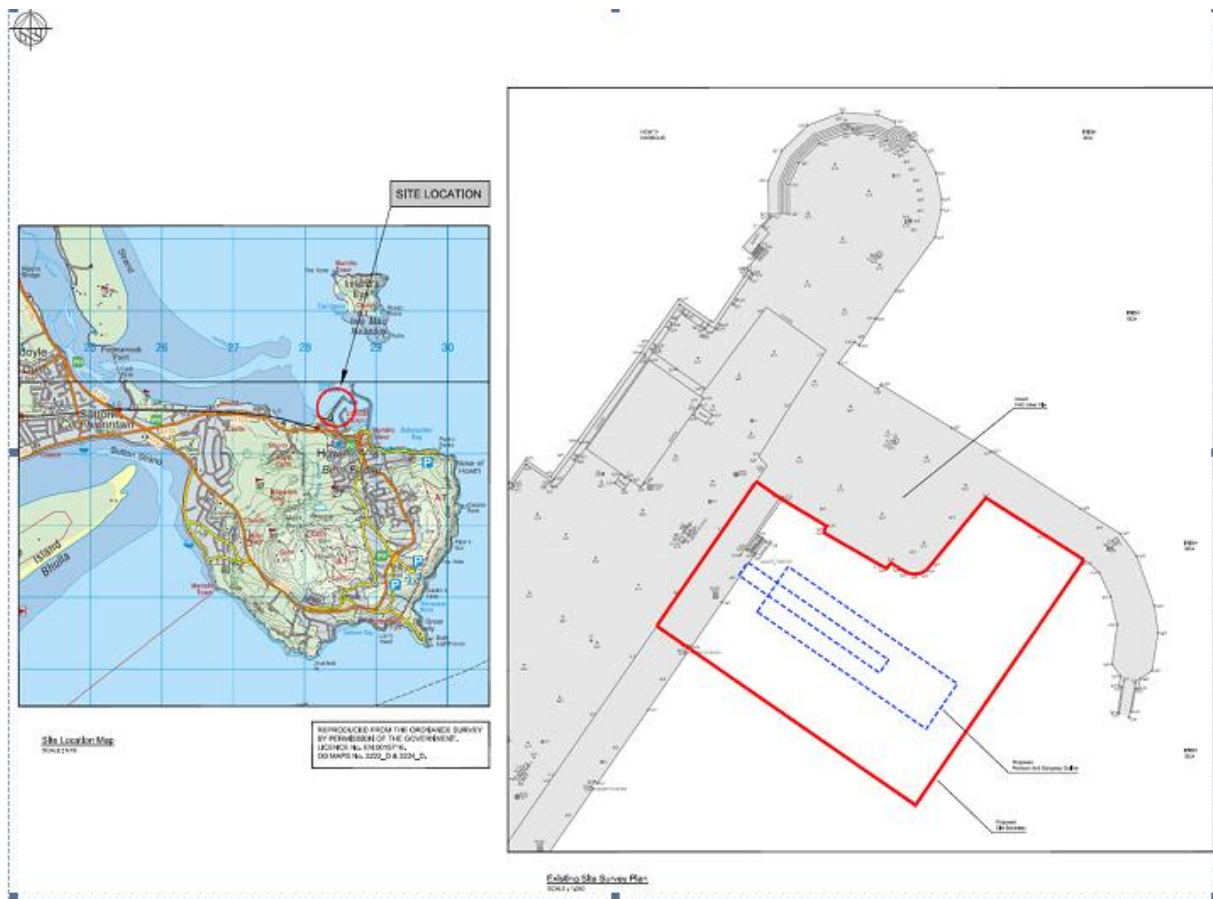

The works are being advanced by a marine contractor working from a jack-up barge 18m by 18m in size, using heavy civil engineering plant and machinery, work vessels and platforms. Divers will be employed on-site to install anodes to the piles.

For safety reasons, mariners are requested to proceed slowly and with caution in the Trawler Dock of Howth Fishery Harbour Centre and to give the works a wide berth. Wave-wash from vessels should be avoided.

These works are expected to be on-going until end of December 2016, weather permitting.
