

Marine Notice No. 59 of 2014

Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishermen, Yachtsmen and Seafarers

Corrib Gas Pipeline Works: Corrib Field to Broadhaven Bay.

The Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport has been advised of rock placement on the newly installed P3 / P6 flowlines at the Corrib location, and remedial rock placement on the 20" gas pipeline and control umbilical. The work will be undertaken at the Corrib field location and along the pipeline corridor to the landfall at Broadhaven Bay. The vessel to be used will be the "Nordnes", Call sign **PHOG**.

Well P3 and well P6 Flowline Rock Placement

This work will all take place within the 500m Safety Zone surrounding the Corrib subsea facilities, and more specifically at:

Pipeline and Umbilical Remedial Rock Placement

This will be undertaken from the Corrib offshore field location to landfall at Glengad, Co Mayo.

P3 / P6 rock placement works will commence on 19th October 2014 at the Corrib Field. Following that, the remedial rock placement will be undertaken on the pipeline and umbilical. The work will be completed by early November 2014.

All mariners are reminded of their responsibilities under the International Collision Regulations and are reminded of [Marine Notice No. 17 of 2007](#), which gives general advice in relation to the activities of vessels engaged in survey work for hydrographic, seismic, fishing research and underwater operations.
